





Scholarship Opportunities

LEAD Awards

\$5,000 is automatically awarded to residential students committed to participating in campus activities; \$2,500 to commuters.

Phi Theta Kappa

\$5,000 is awarded to Phi Theta Kappa members who attended two-year institutions, have a minimum of 30 transferable hours and a cumulative GPA of 3.5+.

Transfer Scholarships

Transfer Scholarships range from \$3,000 to \$4,000 based on a student's cumulative GPA.
